Pray for One Another

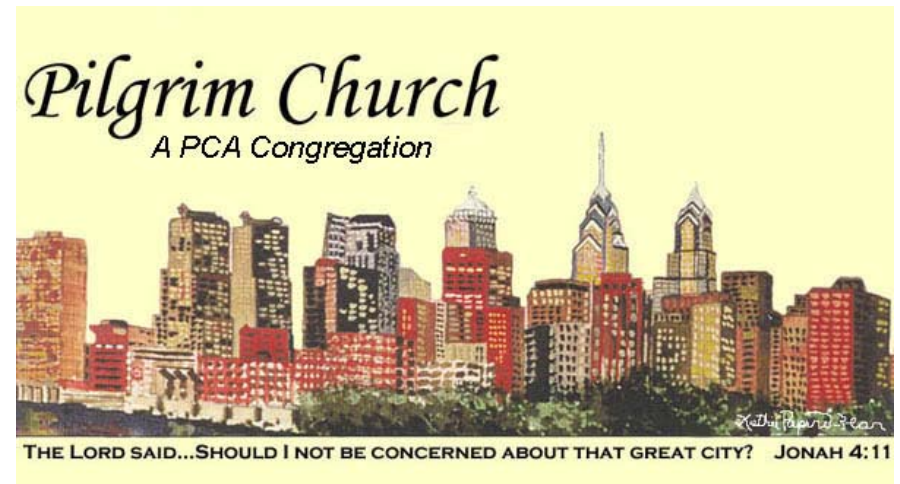
- Pray that all of Pilgrim will be strengthened with constant courage to share the gospel message.
