- Pray that every Christian at Pilgrim will commit to one of the ten outreach teams seeking to reach every man, woman and child in our area with the gospel.

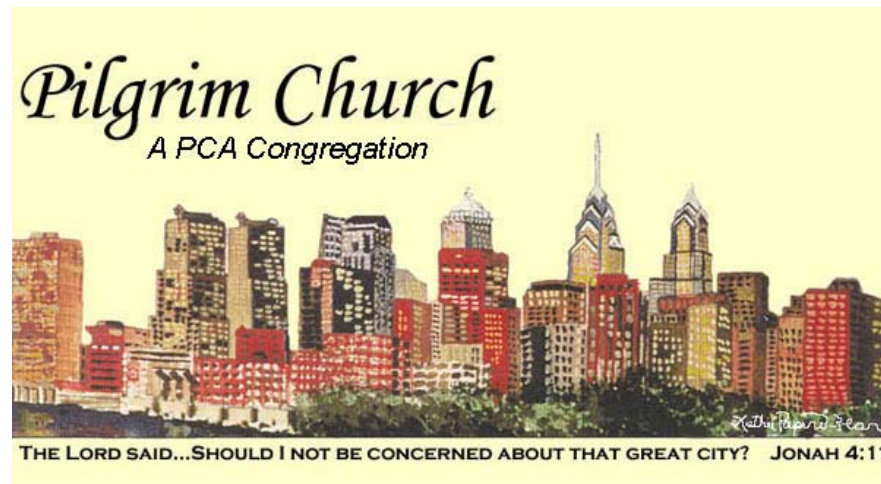
