Pray for One Another

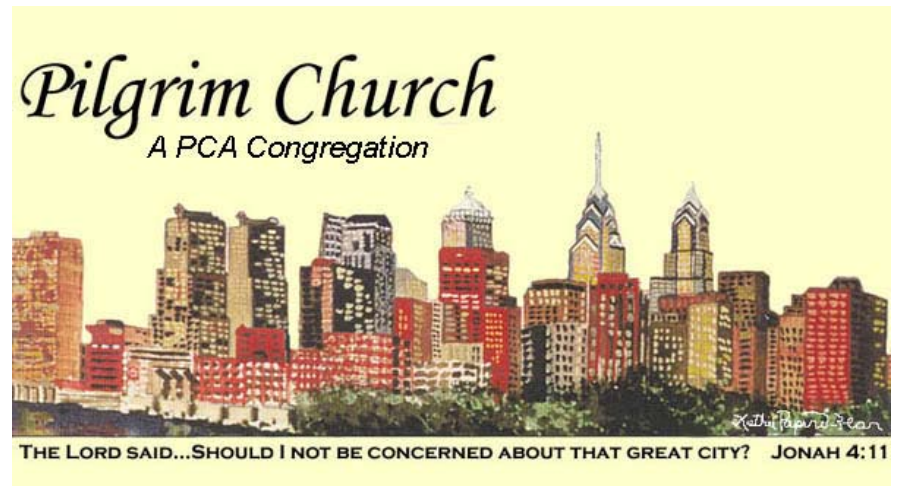
- Pray that all Pilgrim will be encouraged with the life Jesus gives them.
